Dates of camp: July 29 – August 2, 2019

Location: Victoria College of Art 1625 Bank Street Victoria, BC

Position is open until filled. Complete and submit the Volunteer Application Form.

Description: Leader in Training (full time or part time position)

Girls Rock Camp Victoria Volunteers are self-identified women, trans, or non-binary individuals. The Leader in Training volunteer position is held by a youth aged 15 to 18 who has previously attended Girls Rock Camp Victoria as a camper. The position allows a former camper to share the skills they have previously learned at Girls Rock Camp as well as any additional skills they may have in music and/or child care. The Leader in Training volunteer will work closely with Girls Rock Camp volunteers to develop a unique assistance position; tasks may involve (but are not limited to) assisting in instrument tutorials, supervising band rehearsals, set up of gear, break time food prep, and participation in workshops as necessary. At no point will the Leader in Training volunteer be left to supervise campers without the presence of a Girls Rock Camp volunteer.

This position will require occasional heavy lifting (musical equipment). The location is in an old multi-story schoolhouse with multiple flights of stairs. GRCVI is willing to work with individual applicants' abilities with regards to the duties of each position. The venue is not wheelchair accessible.

All Girls Rock Camp Victoria volunteers are expected to model positive behaviour at all times.

GRCVI thanks all applicants for their time in submitting an application. Only those short-listed will be contacted for interview. Please note that all applicants are required to undergo a BC Criminal Record Check at no cost to the applicant, though this is not required of the Leader in Training position.

Availability: Shifts are based on availability. There is a mandatory volunteer orientation immediately preceding the week of camp and all volunteers are invited to attend the Final Showcase performance.

About GRCVI: Girls Rock Camp Victoria is a BC-registered non-profit society. We are currently 100% volunteer-run. Like all Girls Rock Camps around the world, we are independently run and rely solely on the resources of our society, its volunteers, and any funds received through business partnerships, grants, and other donations. The purpose of Girls Rock Camp Victoria is to provide self-identified girls, trans, and non-binary youth with a safe and positive space where they can learn about music while exploring some of the specific issues and challenges they face in our culture as youth, including lack of confidence, lack of positive role modelling, lack of positive outlets for self-expression, and lack of exposure to peers from other economic and cultural backgrounds.
